5. Delphinium, white	1 spike

7. Echinacea, any cultivar	3 stems
8. Hemerocallis (Day lily), single predominantly light coloured	1 scape
9. Hemerocallis (Day lily), double predominantly light coloured	1 scape
10. Lupinus (Lupin) one colour	1 stalk
11. Lupinus (Lupin), bi-colour	1 stalk
12. <b>R</b> . Rosa, any type, any colour	1 bloom
13. <b>R</b> . Rosa, hybrid tea any colour	1 bloom
14. <b>RR</b> . Rosa, hybrid tea red	1 bloom
15. <b>R</b> . Rosa, hybrid tea David Austen	1 bloom/stem
16. <b>R</b> . Rosa, miniature Rose	1bloom/spray
17. <b>R</b> . Rosa, shrub rose, any colour	1 bloom/stem
18. <b>R</b> . Rosa, Grandiflora, any colour	1 bloom/stem

19. <b>R</b> . Rosa, floating in water (no foliage/side bud)	1 bloom
20. <b>R</b> Climbing/Rumbling Rose	1 Stem
21. Rudbeckia (Black-eyed Susan)	3 stems
22. Garden favourite, small blooms less than 2"	3 stems
23. Garden favourite, large blooms over 2"	3 stems

  From OJES page 143: Layer A design characterized by superimposing different surfaces either naturally or manipulated to form a more elaborate or striking effect. The material may be placed horizontally, vertically or diagonally. There is no focal area but there is a linear thrust to the design that is built up layer by layer.
